Thanksgiving - a Way of Seeing

Rabbi Harold Kushner writes in his book, Who Needs God: "Religion is not primarily a set of beliefs, a collection of prayers or a series of rituals. Religion is first and foremost a way of seeing. It doesn't change the facts about the world we live in, but it can change the way we

see those facts, and that in itself can often make a difference."

The typical pattern of God's activities throughout scriptures is that God acts first. Then our proper response to God's actions is praise and thanksgiving -- to see God's hand in what has happened. God did not tell the world, "If you only had enough faith, I would send Jesus to suffer and die for your sins." It was because we had no faith that he sent Jesus. God doesn't wait to find enough faith. God acts first. God's actions are to lead to a faithful - that is thankful - response. The important question to ask is not, "What do you believe?" but "What differences does it make that you believe?"

Those who study the Christian life suggest that as we mature and grow in our faith, there are seven key characteristics to look for:

- Seeks spiritual growth, both alone and with others
- Believes God is present and active in the world
- Acts out of a commitment of faith
- Is active with God's people
- Possesses a positive, hopeful spirit
- Lives out a life of service
- Lives a Christian moral life.

Practice the ways these are nurtured in your life. It is true that faith affects lives. It influences how we interpret and respond to what we experience. Being thankful is a statement of faith. Desiring to share is a statement of faith. Understanding that we have responsibilities beyond ourselves is a statement of faith. Involvement in the church programs and ministries are both opportunities for growth and a practice of faith. May God bless you richly as you learn and grow, give and serve.
